## WHITE WINES

### ET FILLE

#### 2018 VIOGNEIR

*Winemaker, Jessica Mozeico*

This crisp, higher acid white is a 2018 Viognier from Deux Vert Vineyard in the Yamhill-Carlton AVA and represents what we love about Viognier... a lush aromatic nose tempered by lean acidity and minerality. We think what makes this Viognier unique is that it is from a single vineyard in the cool climate Willamette Valley and that we ferment it entirely in small lot stainless steel, allowing us to increase complexity and eliminate oak influences.

### HELIOTERRA

#### 2018 MELON DE BOURGOGNE - CONCRETE

Our Oregon "Muscadet." We fermented and aged our Melon wine for a full year in a concrete egg-shaped tank. The natural convection that occurs due to thermodynamics causes the wine to constantly stir the lees throughout the year. This wine takes on a rich and creamy, textural expression. It shows notes of stone fruits, minerality and crushed stones.

#### 2019 RIESLING

Jess produces Riesling in Salem, Oregon at Walter Scott Winery. The grapes are grown by John Stehlik of Van Horn Vineyard in the amazing Columbia Gorge AVA. This Riesling is delicious and made without superfluous intervention. 2019 Pierce Riesling is bottled in 500ML refillable bottles under crown cap, with a 10 cent refund in Oregon. These bottles can be refilled 25 times when you return to an Oregon bottle drop. The grapes, wine, glass, and packaging are all made in Oregon.

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## PINOT NOIRS

### DION VINEYARD

#### 2016 CHEHALEM PINOT NOIR

2016 Chehalem Mts Pinot Noir is a blend of Old Vine Pommard, Dijon clones of 115, 114, 667, and 777 all from our estate vineyard. A nose of lemon peel and blood orange, with a hint of graphite and spice. The flavor erupts on the palate with a strong pie cherry core supported by pleasant acidity. Mid-palate lingers with cola, structure, and ripe red fruits, followed with a little clove and white pepper. A lingering finish shows pomegranate and notes of cream and butter. 30% new oak

### DAY WINES

#### 2016 MOMTAZI VINEYARD PINOT NOIR

*Winemaker, Brianne Day*

Momtazi Vineyard is a certified biodynamic site nestled in the foothills of the Cascade Range. Easily Day's most intense and deeply fruited Pinot noir, the wine displays hallmark Momtazi notes of black cherry and black raspberry, both on the nose and on the palate. Additional notes of sandalwood spice and forest floor emerge with air, giving a glimpse at the complexity to come. The tannins are suave but sturdy, and the well-integrated acidity holds everything together seamlessly in an enchanting marriage of power and finesse.

#### 2016 VINTNERS SELECT PINOT NOIR

Nicknamed "The Grande Dame," this wine is made from the best barrel from each vineyard source. In 2016, we selected Pinot noir from Bjornson, Lias and Apolloni Vineyards. It is a blend of five clones which lends to the complexity of this wine. This Pinot Noir feminine and red fruited in nature, yet is rich and contemplative, and built for time in the cellar.

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## MID-WEIGHT REDS

### HELIOTERRA WINES 2016 DION VINEYARD SYRAH

A rare cool-climate Syrah grown in the Willamette Valley. These grapes get a long growing season, lending to deep and complex flavors. It is fermented with natural yeast and aged in neutral oak for one and a half years. It expresses notes of berry bramble, white peppercorn, spice and blackberry. This Syrah has a spicy palate with serious umami.

### RIDGECREST VINEYARD 2019 OLD VINE GAMAY

A "Cru Beaujolais" style Gamay from Ribbon Ridge AVA. These vines are now the oldest Gamay plantings in the Willamette Valley. The wine was made with spontaneous primary fermentation, partial whole cluster in the fermentor, and full Malo-Lactic secondary fermentation. Delicious as a juicy red on its own, and does well with many varieties of food, and even served with a slight chill.

### BRYN MAWR VINEYARD 2015 TEMPRANILLO

Medium violet red in color. The nose is powerful and complex, resonating with deep roasted coffee, wood spice, and vanilla. High-pitched sweet fig and dried cherry notes meld to make a dynamic and intriguing nose. The palate starts with a smooth attack, but then the structure of the wine reveals itself as full and tactile. The finish is long and lingering, with notes of cherry and spice.

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## BIG REDS

### **GONZALES WINE COMPANY 2019 REVOLUTION**

2019 'The Revolutionary' Petit Verdot: The 2019 expression of The Revolutionary is 100% Petit Verdot, a varietal that is largely underrepresented as a single varietal wine.

These Washington-grown Petit Verdot grapes were fermented using wild yeast and aged in neutral oak for 10 months. With an herbaceous blueberry nose, a dried cranberry and plum palate, and wet stones and cherry finish, this wine is delicious alone or at your dinner table.

### **LEAH JORGENSEN CELLARS 2019 CABERNET FRANC**

*Winemaker, Leah Jorgensen*

This wine always begins with the most lovely perfumed notes, expressive, fresh, bright, vibrant - always with intense floral aromas, sweet fruit and spice. This vintage digs in deeper with concentrated, sweet fruits of ripe cherries, cassis, brambles, then offers a classic woody spectrum of cherry tobacco, bark, and then finishes with spicy, earthy notes. On the palate, this is a dry wine with ripe fruit flavors of black cherries, black currants, and then meanders to cherry tobacco, anise, clove and black pepper. It's rich with firm tannins on the finish, yet elegant and balanced.
